

2019 ANNUAL REPORT

TO THE ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL SWINE REGISTRY

It is my pleasure to present the following information as compiled in the annual report of the National Swine Registry, an LLC partnership comprised of the American Yorkshire Club, Hampshire Swine Registry, United Duroc Swine Registry and the American Landrace Association. The Yorkshire, Hampshire, and Duroc associations each represent a 30 percent stake in the financial affairs of the NSR, while the Landrace are represented by 10 percent. Collectively, these four breeds represent more than 80 percent of the purebred hog registrations in the country and are incorporated into the breeding schemes utilized by commercial swine production throughout the world. The structure of the NSR is such that nearly all the income and expenses accrue to and flow through the organization.

The format of this report will be unconventional, as many of the breed boards met to conduct essential and timely business via conference call. Leadership was sensitive to the circumstances regarding COVID-19, and encouraged major discussions and decisions to be tabled until an in-person meeting could be conducted. If you have questions or comments regarding the business that was conducted, please review the Breed Board Recap and feel free to reach out to your respective breed boards or NSR staff.

This report typically highlights the status of the association in the previous year. The following statement was drafted prior to the COVID-19 Pandemic; however, I believe it is still relevant for us to reflect on the previous year as we make critical decisions that affect our future.

2019 was certainly a year that brought many changes to the industry. Foreign Animal Disease threats, a poor agriculture economy, changes in events, and a changing purebred swine industry are just a few of the turbulent experiences many in our membership endured in 2019. Our largest event, formerly the World Pork Expo, is now The Exposition. A crossbred swine registry has been established, our magazine and online marketing capabilities have been enhanced, and a new Certified Duroc™ meat program is gaining momentum. Moreover, the National Junior

Swine Association continues to drive enthusiasm and exponential growth in youth participating in the exhibition of purebred swine. With almost 10,000 members, the NJSA is recognized as the largest junior livestock association in the country. NSR Annual Meeting Highlights

GENERAL

All breed boards evaluated and approved financials, voted for breed board officers and representatives to the NSR Executive Committee and selected judges for the 2020 show schedule. This information and highlights can be found at nationalswine.com. Furthermore, each breed voted and approved annual contributions to the National Junior Swine Association. Additionally, staff are determining potential dates to host a live meeting with breed boards to discuss strategic initiatives. Moreover, decisions regarding auctioneers will be determined at the end of the 2020.

DUROC

- Doug Albright was elected as President, Jayson Butts as Vice President.
- Justin Rodibaugh was appointed to the Executive Committee to fill Cody McCleery's seat.
- Continue Weanling Donation Animals at NSR Fall Classic (Beyers Farms and Platt Showpigs will provide animals for 2020)

HAMPSHIRE

- Mark Peter was elected as President, Kyle Baade as Vice President.
- Mike Watson was appointed to the Executive Committee to fill Dusty Cain's seat.
- Premiums were set for the 2020 Hampshire-Sired Barrow Class. The program will end in 2020 and will merge with the Purebred Influenced Crossbred Class in 2021.
- Discussion occurred around breed profile testing. It was recommended to move to a Pass/Fail form of reporting Hampshire test results beginning January 1, 2021. The board will seek input from membership and decide this summer.
- The Hampshire Board recommends the Executive Committee evaluate the selection of judges at events to better manage finances. Staff can select judges for multiple breeds from each breeds approved judges list.
- Hampshire will have the NJSA Foundation Female Representative- Kilmer Farms

LANDRACE

- Jonas McGrew was elected as President, Mark Korb as Vice President.
- The board reviewed the success of the OYE Donation gilt program to generate funds for OYE Landrace Gilt Exhibitors. The board and staff are seeking members willing to donate.
- Significant discussion ensued regarding the current state of breed profile testing. Considerations included providing breeders with percentage information without jeopardizing international markets, plans to increase requirements, and how breed profile testing would affect junior members. Ultimately, the board decided to wait until more test data was gathered through spring and summer of 2020 to assess the breed profile testing.
- It was recommended that Landrace collaborate with Yorkshire if an auctioneer change is made.

YORKSHIRE

- Steve Cobb was elected President, Kevin Ricker as Vice President.
- Steve Cobb was reappointed to the Executive Committee.
- Yorkshires discussed options for an Auctioneer in 2021. The discussion as tabled until after the Fall Classic.
- The Yorkshire board voted to recommend the Executive Committee evaluate farrowing date requirements for the Exposition and STC/NJSS in 2021 to allow Octobers at the Exposition and Novembers at STC/NJSS.
- The board asked staff to review current award structures and consider a Top 5 Sire AI Certificate Award. Other discussion ensued around enhancing current award structures.

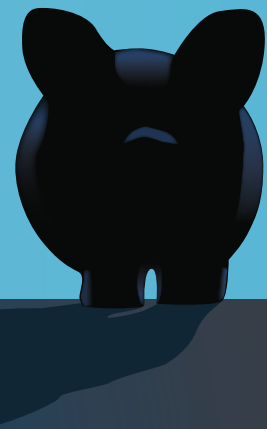
