# 2021 ANNUAL REPORT

## TO THE MEMBERS AND STAKEHOLDERS OF THE NATIONAL SWINE REGISTRY

It is my pleasure to present the following information as compiled in the annual report of the National Swine Registry, a partnership comprised of the American Yorkshire Club, Hampshire Swine Registry, United Duroc Swine Registry and the American Landrace Association. The Yorkshire, Hampshire, and Duroc associations each represent a 30 percent stake in the financial affairs of the NSR, while the Landrace are represented by 10 percent. Collectively, these four breeds represent more than 80 percent of the purebred hog registrations in the country and are incorporated into the breeding schemes utilized by commercial swine production throughout the world. The structure of the NSR is such that nearly all the income and expenses accrue to and flow through the organization.

2021 for the NSR, as it was for many, was a year of forward progress while also beginning to return to some semblance of normalcy. Breeding stock and weanling sales were strong, culminated by 9 new world-record selling animals through NSR events in their respective breeds. Pedigrees and registrations made a solid return as events that were cancelled in 2020 began their resurgence and the global demand for pork continues to drive interest in commercial registrations and the Certified DUROC® Pork Program. Moreover, the full implementation of online bidding services, the forward progression of the Draft Virtual Sire Sale, and the first ever Collector's Edition Bred Female sale demonstrated the association's commitment to progressive new ideas and optimizing resources available to better assist all members in merchandising their animals.

Finally, new collaboration with the American Berkshire Association to participate in all NSR Open Events and become a full partner of NJSA will only continue to advance opportunities for purebred swine breeders and fuel the collaborative spirit across multiple swine breed associations.

NJSA continues to be the driver of much of our business, with youth swine projects building demand for purebred genetics. The interest in swine exhibition has never been higher, and NSR governance has created new opportunities through programs like Purebred-Influenced Crossbred Divisions, new shows, and events, and expanded premium and award recognition. Ad-

ditionally, the NSR Foundation has a record number of funds available to help future leaders grow and develop through scholarship programs and leadership opportunities. These efforts have created a new campaign on behalf of the NSR Foundation, the YES (Youth Education Scholarship) Campaign. Through generous contributions of grassroots fundraising and corporate sponsors, the goal is to raise \$500,000 in new scholarship funds over the next five years. Moreover, the NSR has committed to match every dollar raised up to \$100,000. This new fund will insure the sustainability of talent and leadership for the swine industry. Despite all these exciting advancements, the driver of success for the registry continues to be the support and resiliency of our membership. I humbly invite you as members to study the status of the association carefully.

While the members are the life blood of the organization, the NSR staff are the beating heart. It never ceases to impress me the amount of dedication, passion and commitment our staff has for the organization and its mission and goals. Your work ethic, professional service, and resiliency does not go unnoticed and is very much appreciated.

Additionally, thank you to our dedicated breed boards and executive committee members for your leadership and service to the largest swine breed registry in America.
